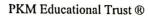
Report on "Earth Day -2022" on 28/04/2022


A rally on HELMET Awareness was organized by the department on 13th February 2019 at 3PM

Objective:

To create awareness among public, faculty and students regarding need of helmets in preventing head injuries and death and to promote safe riding habits.

The head and brain is most vulnerable to injury in a motorcycle accident. Drivers and passengers wearing helmets increase their chance of survival significantly over non-helmet wearers. It is important for motorcyclists to understand the risks of riding without a helmet. Riders who do not wear helmets are at risk of suffering a traumatic brain injury if they are in an accident. Without protection, the head is vulnerable to a traumatic impact in an accident even when traveling at low speeds. Because of the fatal risk of traumatic brain injury is so high, it is crucial for motorcyclists to take action to protect themselves while riding. Wearing a helmet that is approved by the Department of Transportation is one of many precautions a rider can take to increase safety on the open road. To create an awareness on the same a rally from RRIT campus to Sapthagiri medical college was organized. 27 students and faculty of the department actively participated in the rally.





REPORT ON ADOPTED VILLAGES UNDER UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN

BACK GROUND:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is the Flagship program of MHRD that links Higher education Institutions to adopt minimum of 5 villages. The institutions can work towards the betterment of the villages adopted and work to bring transformation in rural development processes by leveraging institutions to help build the architecture of an "Inclusive India". R R Institute of Technology has adopted following five villages in the vicinity of its campus:

- Ivarakandapura
- Thammenahalli
- Somashettihalli
- Ganigarahalli
- Guniagrahara

Further, as per the directions received from MHRD, RRIT has started to work on base line survey of the identified villages and met PDO of Ivarkandapura village on 16/07/21 and met Gram Panchayat members and briefed the UBA activity got support to carry out survey following Covid-19 protocol.

Also the coordinator UBA visited Ganigarahalli and Somashetty Halli Panchayat and met PDO on 27/8/2021 and carried village baseline survey with memebers. A Baseline village survey is carried out on 01/9/2021 at Guniagrahara village after meeting the PDO and discussed on grab shaba activity carried out for the development of village.

Also the Coordinator visited Thammenahalli village on 16/9/2021 and met PDO and discussed on covid-19 situation to carry out baseline survey in the village . The PDO suggested to carry survey after complete lifting of lock down.

The Coordinator UBA discussed with the team to carry out survey in the village. The coordinator organized meeting with members on 9/10/2021 and discussed on household survey to be carried in all the 5 villages. As per suggestion of members and keeping safety of all the members of the committee suggested to carry out survey post January month.

As part of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) scheme the institute has carried out house hold village survey as per the plan and formulated a team of 40 NSS students. RRIT NSS Students have actively participated to carry the survey and filed the form as given by UBA.

During the survey ,students have spread the awareness of various schemes offered by government for the upliftment of families residing in the village. Through the survey the institute were able to study the lacuna and further development activity that to be carried out in future for the overall development villages where survey is carried out.

Students expressed that they will spread awareness of unnat bharat abhyan scheme to all and will actively participate in future if any activity to be carried out under UBA scheme.





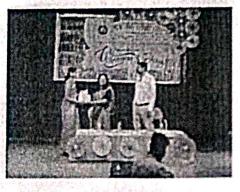

Report of International Women's Day-2022

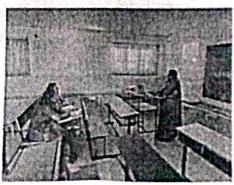
International Women's Day was celebrated in RR. Institutions to encourage women in RR Institutions with various activities.

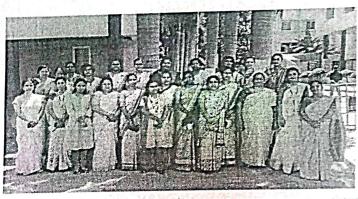

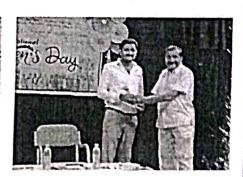



The work was resumed again giving final finishing to the cleaned area. The students were involved voluntarily in cleaning the weeds, shrubs and other unwanted growth of plants.





Report on Vaccination Drive







