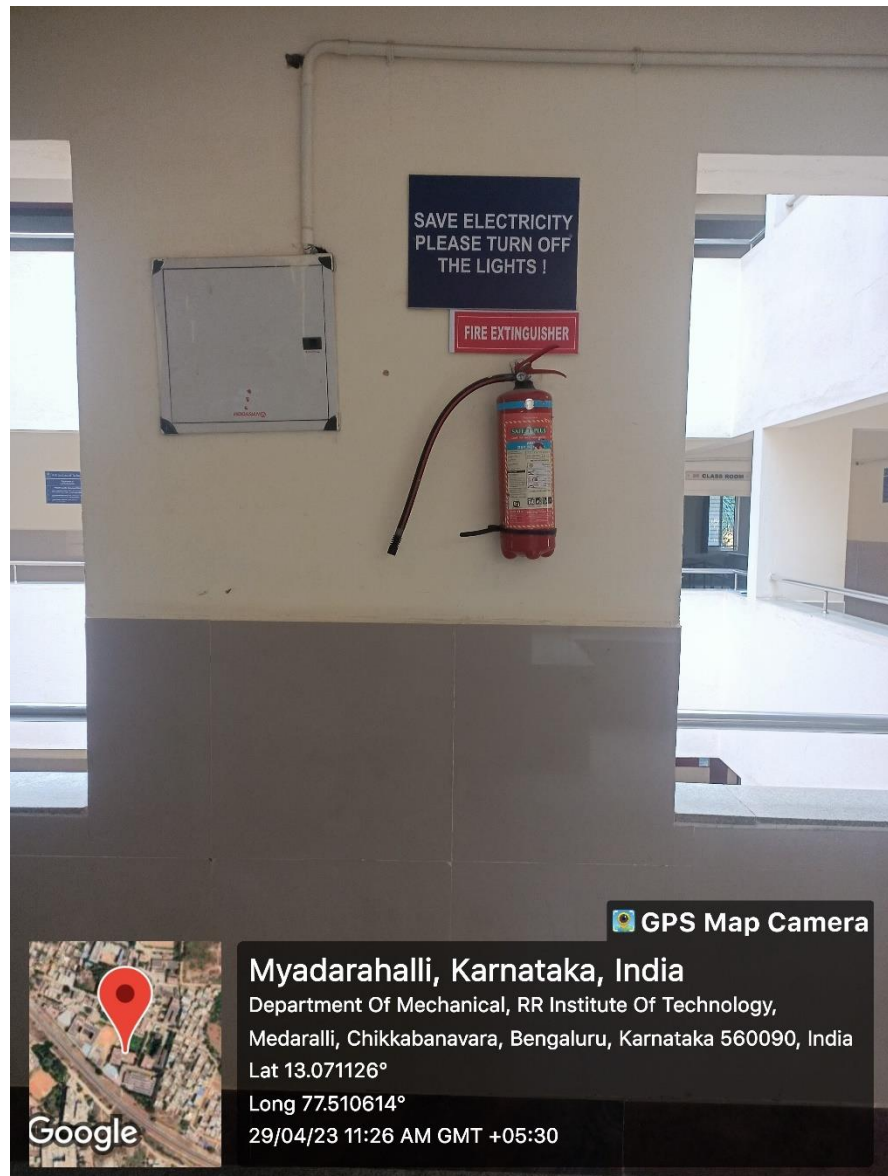


Fig. 3. Fire Extinguishers

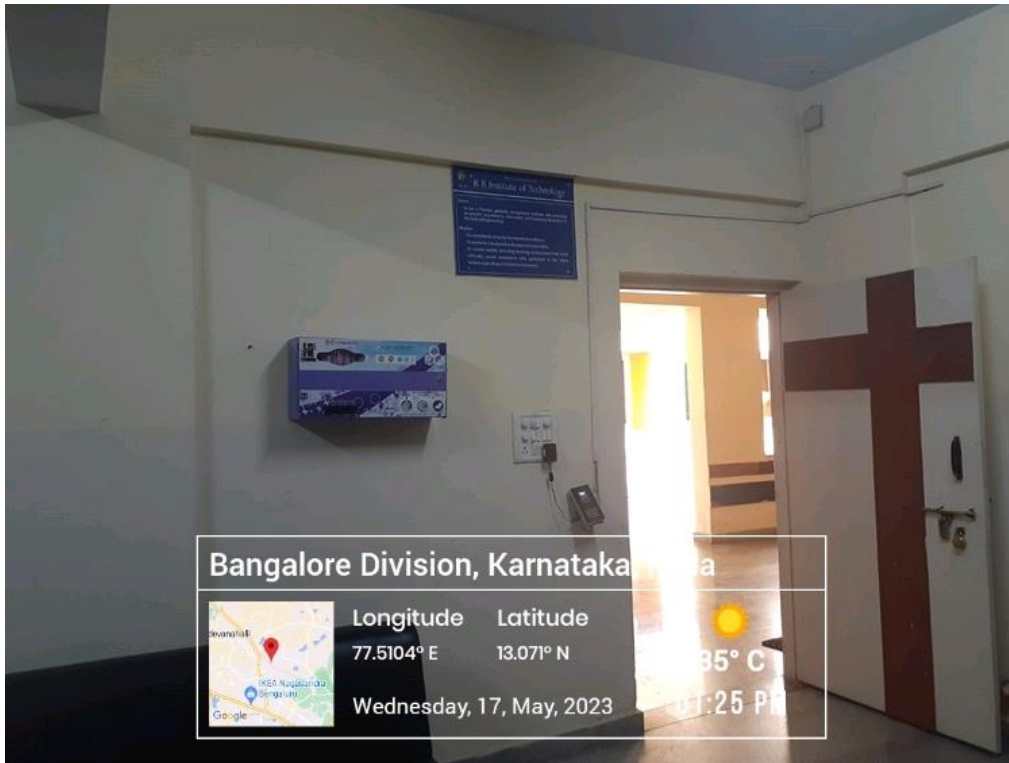


Fig. 4. Girls Common room

Report of International Women's Day-2022

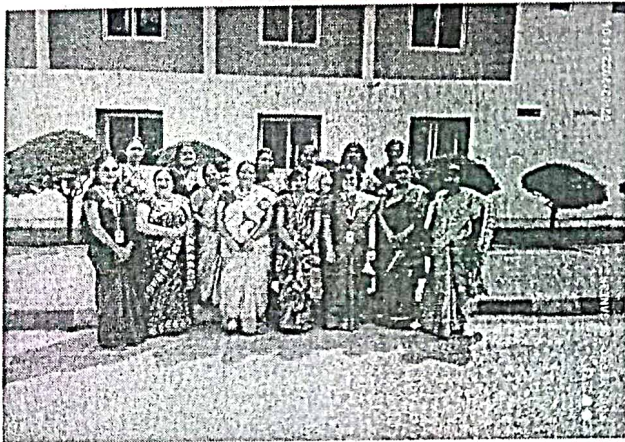
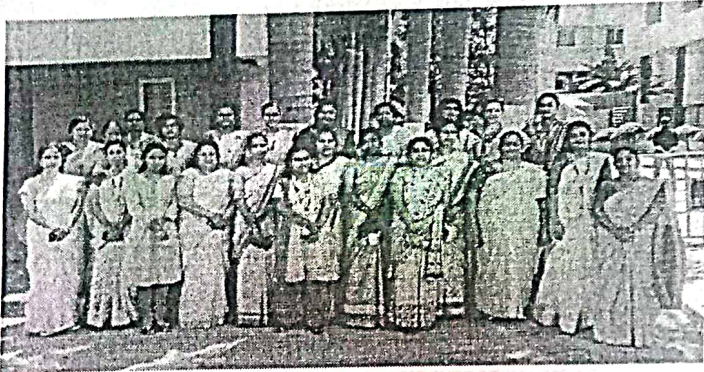
International Women's Day was celebrated in RR. Institutions to encourage women in RR Institutions with various activities.

On 14/12/2020, Department of Basic Sciences conducted a Quiz according to subject wise.

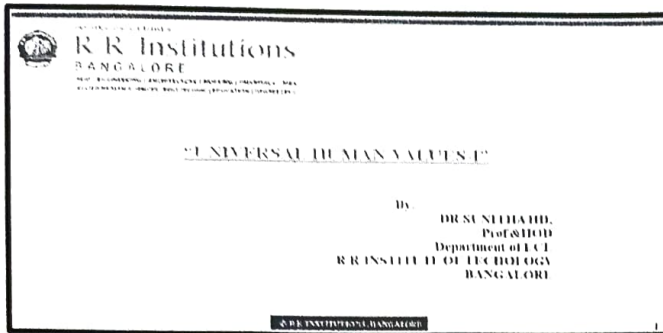

In the session **Dr. sunitha H D** explained about skills and values for achieving the Goal of Education. She further talked about types of values and also the importance of values.

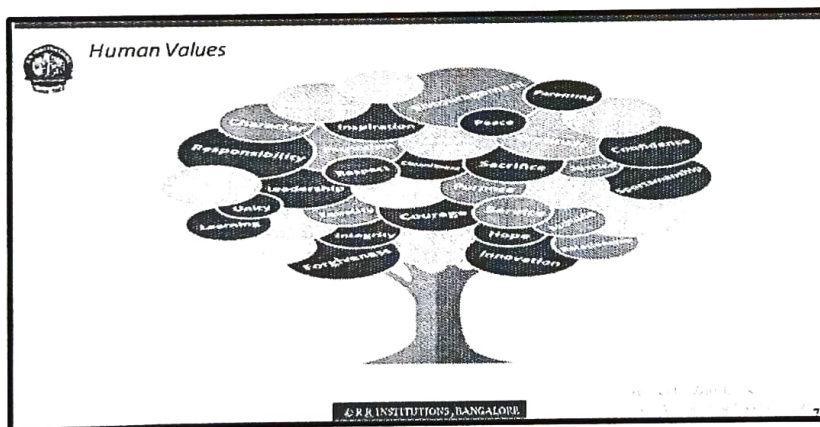

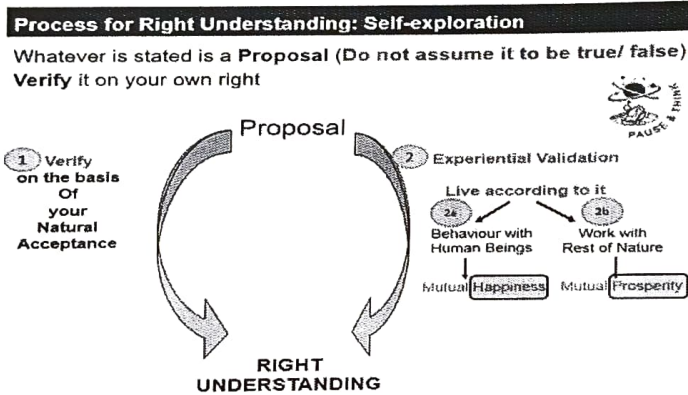
- **Universal Human Values-II (Self and Body, Peer Pressure and English, Prosperity)**

However, the various versions of what is understood by universal human values - Self and Body, Peer Pressure and English, Prosperity proposed by Professor Parimala Gandhi, IQAC co-ordinator.

Universal Values

- Happiness is universally valuable to human beings. This leads to identify and set the right goals and the right direction.
- Values are the evaluative standards for deciding “what is right and what is wrong, what is good and what is bad, what is desirable and what is undesirable.”
- Human Values can be understood by an appropriate process of self-discovery:
- “what I am” -my desires, my thoughts, my expectations; -my imagination the way I feel, the way I think, how I make decisions, what I expect from others and all that.
- “what is naturally acceptable to me”. -When we are in harmony within, we are in state of happiness. When we are in a state of contradiction within, we are in the state of unhappiness.



• Electrical Safety Measures

Electrical Safety Measures session was held in online mode through Microsoft Teams on Wednesday, 16th December 2020 for the 1st semester B.E students of 2020-21 batch. The speaker of session was **Prof. Sunanda C V**, Assistant Professor, Department of EEE, R R Institute of Technology.

Objective of this program was to brief the students regarding the department of electrical engineering, give them a brief into basic concepts of electrical engineering.

The main objective of this : Highlighting the importance of electricity safety and its role to cutting down risks of fire and electric shock in the electric utilities and commercial, educational, industrial and health facilities, to protect peoples and premises and reduce human and economic losses. A glimpse into different electrical accessories and types of lighting that are used in our residential and office spaces.

The safety Measures was explained by the madam are listed below :

- Avoid water at all times when working with electricity. Never touch or try repairing any electrical equipment or circuits with wet hands. It increases the conductivity of electric current.
- Never use equipment with frayed cords, damaged insulation or broken plugs.
- If you are working on any receptacle at your home then always turn off the mains. It is also a good idea to put up a sign on the service panel so that nobody turns the main switch ON by accident.
- Always use insulated tools while working.
- Know the wire code of your country.
- Always put a cap on the hot/live wire while working on an electric board or service panel as you could end up short circuiting the bare ends of the live wire with the neutral. The cap insulates the copper ends of the cable thus preventing any kind of shock even if touched mistakenly.
- Take care while removing a capacitor from a circuit. A capacitor stores energy and if it's not properly discharged when removed it can easily cause an electric shock. An easy way to discharge low voltage capacitor is that after removal from the circuit is to put the tip of two insulated screw drivers on the capacitor terminals. This will discharge it. For high voltage ones a 12 Volts light bulb can be used. Connecting the bulb with the capacitor will light up the bulb using up the last of the stored energy.
- Always take care while soldering your circuit boards. Wear goggles and keep yourself away from the fumes. Keep the solder iron in its stand when not in use; it can get extremely hot and can easily cause burns.

- **Covid – 19 Awareness**

Covid – 19 Awareness Programme was held in online mode through Microsoft Teams on Wednesday, 16th December 2020 for the 1st semester B.E students of 2020-21 batch. The speaker of session was **Dr. Sunitha H D**, Professor & Head, Department of ECE

She demonstrated hand washing technique, health talk regarding COVID -19. And also discussed about Perception about prevention from coronavirus. On the question about whether respondents are preventing from virus, out of the total participants(98.6%) admit that social distancing is crucial to finish virus from transmission. - **Universal Human Value**(Relationships in family, Mulya in Relationship (Trust and Respect), Anger, Four Orders)

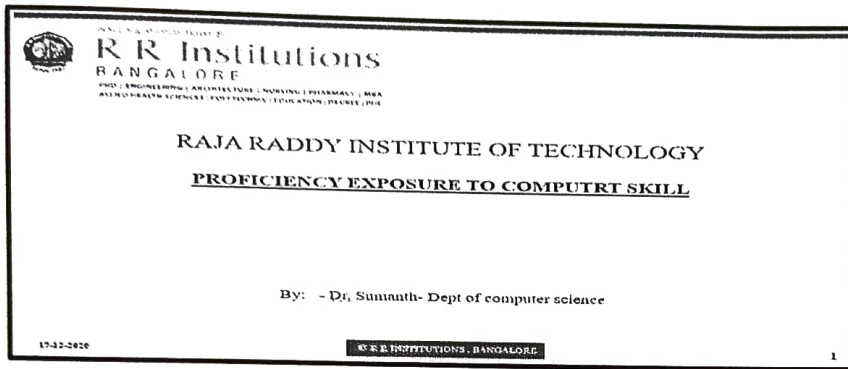

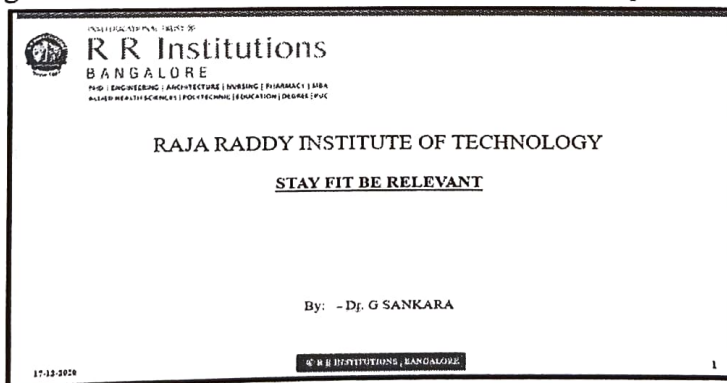

- **Stay Fit and Be Relevant**

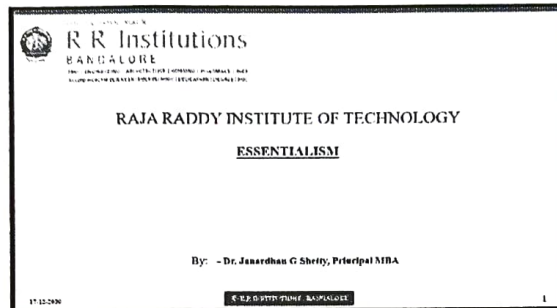

Essentialism is the educational philosophy of teaching basic skills. This philosophy advocates training the mind. Essentialist educators focus on transmitting a series of progressively difficult topics and promotion of students to the next level or grade. Subjects are focused on the historical context of the material world and culture, and move sequentially to give a solid understanding of the present day. This philosophy stresses core knowledge in reading, writing, math, science, history, foreign language, and technology. The tools include lecturing, memorization, repetition, practice, and assessment.

Objectives :

- Explain the philosophical principles of Essentialism.
- Discuss the educational implications of Essentialism.

Terminologies

Educational Essentialism & is an educational philosophy whose adherents believe that children should learn the traditional basic subjects thoroughly and vigorously. Essence & is the attribute or set of attributes that make an entity or substance what it fundamentally is, and which it has by necessity, and without which it loses its identity. Essentialism in education asserts that common and essential ideas and skills belonging to a certain culture should be taught to all citizens at the same level at especially primary school level. To do this, the teacher's authority in the classroom is emphasised and the subject matter is the centre of the curriculum. The essence or the centre of education is the core curriculum which is a combination of hard work and rigorous effort. The unification role of essentialism is represented in the core curriculum that aims to transfer the essential knowledge and skills needed for the equal and well-balanced citizens. The discrimination function of essentialism comes out in politics, natural sciences in the form of taxonomy.

Day 5 : 18th December 2020

- **Placement and Job Talk**

- by Dr. T. Naveen Kumar, Dean & Professor RRIT.

Dr. T. Naveen Kumar explained about the task of job-hunting may be a daunting one for the job seeker, but, on the flip side, it is also a challenge for employers to find qualified and committed employees. A job placement service acts as an intermediary between the job seeker and the employer. The task of this intermediary person can be two-fold as both a placement specialist and a job developer. This means first of all, to market people trained with skills known to be in high demand in the community; but second, to closely track the requirements of local employers and then direct suitable candidates to training for the jobs or place people who are job-ready. In some cases job placement programs are also designed to offer financial assistance to an employer who hires someone through the placement service and where employment is maintained for a certain length of time, e.g., for six months.

A job placement service usually is and should be closely linked to job search assistance services. In addition, the employment service may need to establish training tailored to fill the gap between the skills that employers require and the skill levels of unemployed community members. For example, in a community with many aging citizens who require additional care either to live at home or within a seniors' facility, there may be an unmet need for people trained in geriatric care and home care. A training service can be designed to prepare workers for such jobs and can then place them. In short, again, the employment services need to be integrated into a systematic human resource development strategy.

Benefits:

Effective job placement programs in connection with other human resource services can help to reduce the length of time that people are unemployed, minimize the stress and struggle of the job search process, and fill the staffing needs of local businesses that contribute to the economic vitality of the community.

The job-seeker will have access to potential jobs that might not be advertised elsewhere and their skills and career objectives can be specifically matched to employment openings.

Employers benefit from having potential candidates pre-screened through the placement service. They do not have to wade through piles of resumes. Only candidates qualified for the position are referred to them.

Major challenges:

When presented with candidates from marginalized populations, employers may be reluctant to hire them because of concerns about reliability, interrupted work history, etc. These concerns

need to be addressed head-on by acknowledging the possibility that someone, who, for example, has suffered from a mental illness, may very well have a day, here and there, on which he is unable to work, but that in other ways the potential employee may be prepared to offer better than usual services.

Funding for employment-related programs often does not extend to some marginalized sectors in the community (such as the under-employed, immigrants, re-entry women, and youth with no work history) who nevertheless require job placement services and could benefit greatly from them.

- **Health Management**

The health management system (HMS) is an evolutionary medicine regulative process proposed by **Prof Merlia K Raju** Asst Prof, RR College Of Nursing , which actuarial assessment of fitness and economic-type cost, benefit analysis determines the body's regulation of its physiology and health.

This incorporation of cost-benefit calculations into body regulation provides a science grounded approach to mind, body phenomena such as placebos that are otherwise not explainable by low level, noneconomic, and purely feedback based homeostatic or allostatic theories.

Why Is Access to Health Services Important?

Access to health services means "the timely use of personal health services to achieve the best health outcomes.

It requires 3 distinct steps:

- Entering the health care system (usually through insurance coverage)
- Accessing a location where needed health care services are provided (geographic availability)
- Finding a health care provider whom the patient trusts and can communicate with (personal relationship)

Access to health care impacts one's overall physical, social, and mental health status and quality of life.

Barriers to health services include:

High cost of care, Inadequate or no insurance coverage, Lack of availability of services and Lack of culturally competent care

These barriers to accessing health services lead to:

Unmet health needs, Delays in receiving appropriate care, Inability to get preventive services, Financial burdens and Preventable hospitalizations

Access to care often varies based on race, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, age, sex, disability status, sexual orientation, gender identity, and residential location.

Improving health care services includes increasing access to and use of evidence-based preventive services. Clinical preventive services are services that:

- Prevent illness by promoting healthy behaviors in people without risk factors (e.g., diet and exercise counseling)
- Prevent illness by providing protection to those at risk (e.g., childhood vaccinations)
- Identify and treat people with no symptoms, but who have risk factors, before the clinical illness develops (e.g., screening for hypertension or colorectal cancer)

In addition to primary care and preventive services, emergency medical services (EMS) are a crucial link in the chain of care. EMS include basic and advanced life support.¹⁷ Notable progress has been made in recent years to ensure that everyone has access to rapidly responding

Timeliness is the health care system's ability to provide health care quickly after a need is recognized. Measures of timeliness include:

- Availability of appointments and care for illness or injury when it is needed
- Time spent waiting in doctors' offices and emergency departments (EDs)

The delay in time between identifying a need for a specific test or treatment and receiving those services can negatively impact health and costs of care. For example, delays in getting care can lead to:

- Increased emotional distress
- Increased complications
- Higher treatment costs
- Increased hospitalizations

Actual and perceived difficulties or delays in getting care when patients are ill or injured likely reflect significant barriers to care. Prolonged ED wait time:

- Decreases patient satisfaction
- Increases the number of patients who leave before being seen
- Is associated with clinically significant delays in care

Causes for increased ED wait times include an increase in the number of patients going to EDs, with much of the increase due to visits by less acutely ill patients. At the same time, the total number of EDs in the United States has decreased.

- **Anti Sexual Harassment and Drug Abuse**

Prof. Parimala Gandhi, IQAC Co-ordinator, informed the students that Anti-sexual harassment and drug abuse information is essential to the students for their own benefit and healthy society.

Prof Parimala Gandhi, addressed students what is sexual harassment and drug abuse, impact of these on own life and society. She addressed student about anti-sexual harassment and drug abuse committee of our institute. This was beneficial to the students to live happily and see surrounding happy. And most important studies will be carried out without such hurdles.

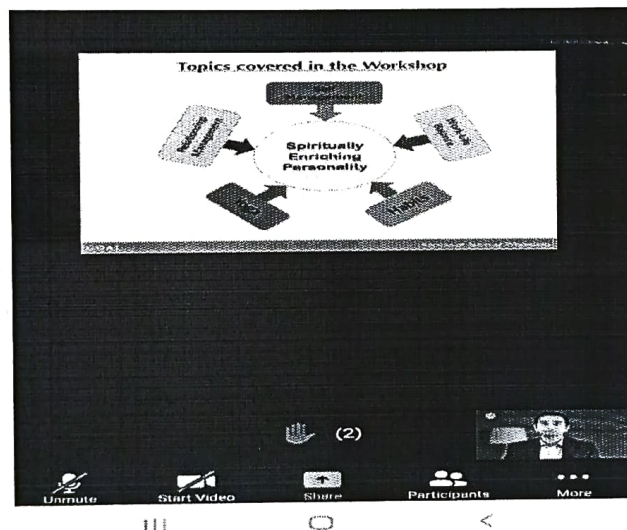
Day 6 : 19th December 2020


The last session on day 6 of the Student Induction Program, conducted on 19th December, 2020 was, Conclusion- Valedictory function.

It began with a welcome address to all the dignitaries, Management, Principal, Head of various departments, faculties and the students who had gathered together.

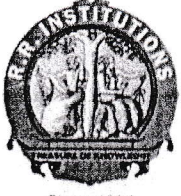
